

First login to the forum with admin user and password.

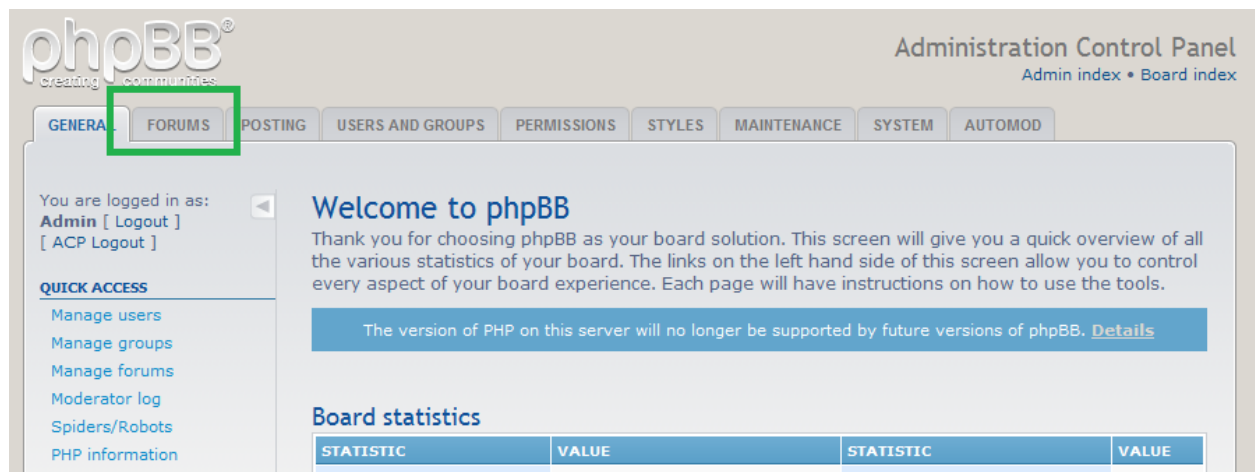
You'll see Administration Control Panel Link on the top.

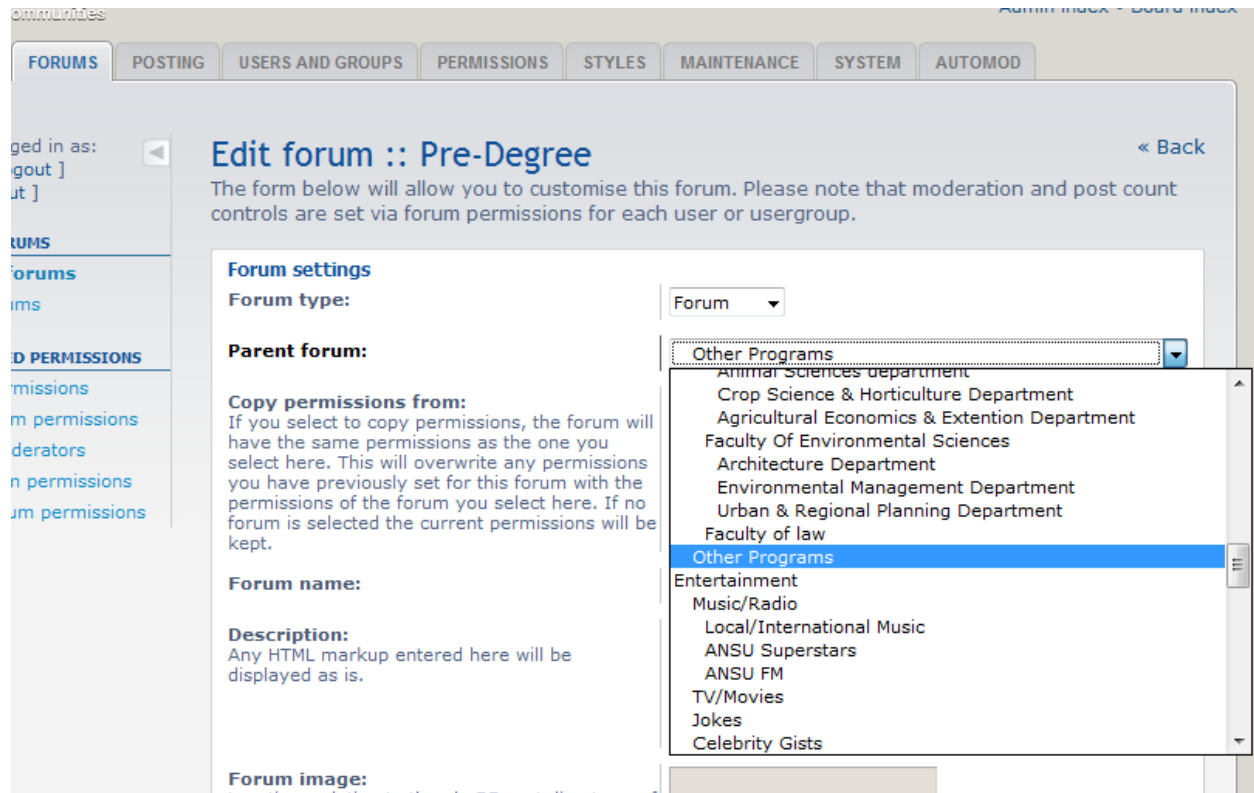
